School Block Challenge 2011 *Fabric Packet Form*

Teachers throughout the United States are invited to enter this annual contest, which challenges the students' creativity with fabric. Moda generously provides over 300 packets of excellent fabrics for the contest. Materials are limited; therefore entry packets will be distributed as requests are received. A small fee for postage will be required for all mailed packets. Cash awards, worth more than \$1,200 will be given to the winning contestants. All blocks will be exhibited at the National Quilt Museum, February 11 through April 4, 2011, for our visitors to enjoy.

Notes:

- ❖ Teachers may receive a maximum of 10 packets; a request for additional packets may be made.
- ❖ Teachers may submit multiple entries, up to the number of students in the class.
- ❖ Blocks are constructed by individual students, by small groups, or by an entire class collectively.
- ❖ A student may only participate in one block.
- ❖ Students are encouraged to work together.
- ❖ Students must be affiliated with a group, such as Girl or Boy Scouts, Youth Group, Boys & Girls Club, School, etc. Cash awards are received by the sponsoring organization.
